

<b>Position</b>	Restorative Justice Facilitator
<b>Description</b>	The Richmond Restorative Justice Program is a pre-charge diversion program aimed at children and youth who have come into conflict with the law. Restorative justice is a community based alternative to the traditional justice system. Trained volunteers facilitate community justice forums, which bring together the victim, offender and their families and supporters for a discussion about the incident and how the harm can be repaired.

<b>Responsibilities/Duties</b>	Interview Community Justice Forum Participants. Facilitate Community Justice Forums. Write resolution agreement and summary reports. Attend monthly facilitator meetings. Attend on-going, relevant training and education workshops. Promote and enhance restorative justice program. Attend relevant Touchstone Family Association training and events.
<b>Qualifications</b>	Excellent communication skills (Oral, written). Effective organization and time management skills. Ability to work independently and as part of a team. Ability to treat clients with respect and fairness. Previous work or volunteer experience with at-risk youth (Families) and/or conflict resolution is an asset. Criminal Record Check required.
<b>Commitment</b>	Volunteers are asked to commit up to 15 hours per month for a minimum of 12 months.
<b>Training</b>	Volunteers will receive 3 full days of community justice forum training from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, followed by a series of workshops in the weeks after.
<b>Benefits</b>	Accreditation as a Community Justice Forum Facilitator. Eligible for additional education and training provided by Touchstone Family Association (i.e., Crisis Prevention, First Aid).
